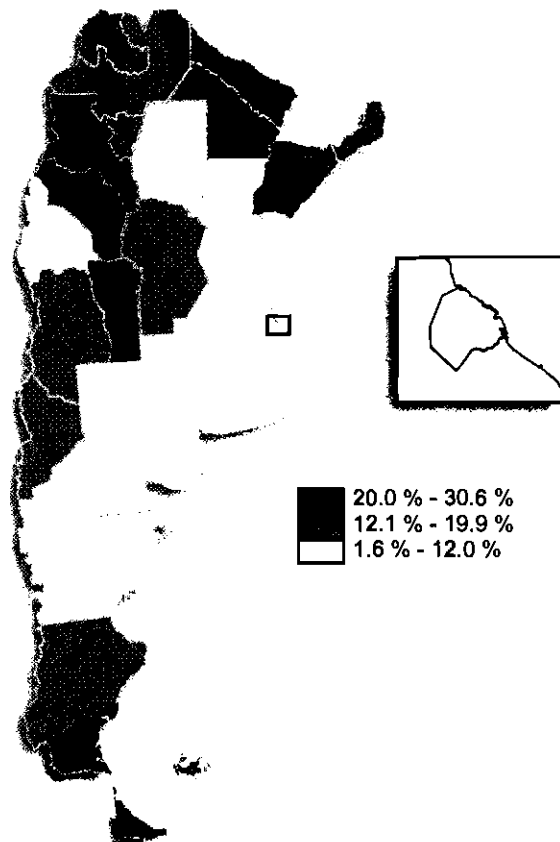

STUDENTS / Percentage Increase 1996 - 2005



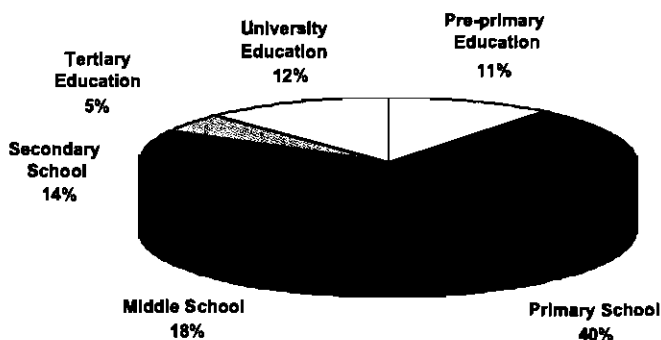
