




Interior view of the Company's Foundry.



**Section showing Desks arranged as Seats.**




**Section showing Desks arranged as Seats, facing opposite direction to that shown in previous section.**

- (I.) It is easy to operate, and in the side swivelled arrangement the leaves are moved in separate pairs.

- (IX.) It is undoubtedly the **BEST** and **MOST EFFECTIVE** folding partition.
- (X.) On page 83 illustrations are given of various stock designs.
- (XI.) Under recent patents the runners now used have **BALL BEARINGS**.








PLAN. Showing an Unusual Arrangement of Sub-Division and Folding.








